Description:	A resource tool which will market healthcare careers in Northwestern Ontario to youth, Aboriginal people and mature learners. This tool will mimic an emergency first aid kit and feature such careers as registered nursing, nursing assistants, medical laboratory technicians, and biotechnology. It will provide information on education and training requirements, where the training is available, local wage rates for occupations, prospects for employment and contact information.	
Project Outcome:	<u>Expected Outcome:</u> The resource tool will be available in libraries, schools, and resource centres to students, teachers, parents, student service offices, job seekers and employment support providers to raise awareness and promote career opportunities in Northwestern Ontario's growing health sector. This tool will also assist with healthcare recruitment challenges in Northwestern Ontario.
